4. **Election of Office Bearer roles**

In line with the RSNH Constitution ratified at the 2020 AGM, separate elections must be held for the positions of President (Chair), Vice-President (Deputy Chair), Secretary and Treasurer. If only one member is nominated for the position, the Chairperson of the meeting must declare the member elected to the position. If more than one member is nominated, a ballot must be held.

5. Election of Ordinary Member (non-Office Bearer) roles

The AGM must also decide by resolution the number of ordinary members of the Committee (if any) it wishes to hold office for the next year. A single election may be held to fill all of those positions.

If the number of members nominated for the position of ordinary committee member is less than or equal to the number to be elected, the Chairperson of the meeting must declare each of those members to be elected to the position.

If the number of members nominated exceeds the number to be elected, a ballot must be held.
